Additional Notes:

- 1. Membership fee includes up to 4 family members (i.e. spouse, significant other, and dependent children under the age of 21). Additional dependents are \$5.00 per person with a maximum of eight (8) people per membership; Junior Seasonal and Young Adult memberships are limited to the member only.
- 2. First year dues waived for Regular membership.
- 3. Junior Seasonal for candidates under the age of 22 prior to the beginning of the season (Memorial Day).
- 4. Young Adult (Age 22-30) available on a limited basis; requires 32 hours of volunteer service to RBSA in exchange for reduced membership fee.
